NOTTINGHAM COUNTRY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT

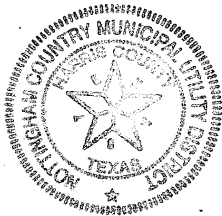
The Board of Directors of Nottingham Country Municipal Utility District will hold a regular meeting on Monday, May 17, 2021, at 11:30 a.m., **by teleconference* at (877) 873-8017, Access Code: 1107286**, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Operations and service requirements relating to COVID-19 epidemic and ratification of any emergency actions, if necessary.
2. Comments from the public.
3. Approve Minutes of prior meetings.
4. Updates from District Committees.
5. West Harris County Regional Water Authority matters, including request submittal for February 2021 freeze event fee adjustment credits.
6. Memorandum of Understanding with Willow Fork Drainage District for Storage Volume in Barker Reservoir.
7. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of bills and review of investments.
8. Tax assessment and collection matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, payment of tax bills, and requests for waivers of penalties and interest.
9. Operation of District facilities, billings, meter maintenance program, and repairs and maintenance, including:
 - a. customer correspondence;
 - b. review Critical Load Spreadsheet for District's facilities and authorize annual filing;
 - c. approve Consumer Confidence Report and authorize operator to deliver Consumer Confidence Report and file certificate of delivery with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality;
 - d. annual inspection for system-wide leak detection; and
 - e. hearing on termination of water service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
10. Engineering matters and capital improvement projects, including authorize design, approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement for bids, review bids and approve award of contract, approve pay estimates, time extensions and change orders, and final acceptance, as appropriate, for the following:
 - a. Water Plant and Well No. 1 flood mitigation, including Resolution Declaring Surplus Property;
 - b. wastewater treatment plant improvements;
 - c. sanitary sewer rehabilitation program;
 - d. District Capital Improvement Plan Budget update;
 - e. development of Geographic Information System;
 - f. proposals for rehabilitation of District facilities and engineering work, including storm water channel improvements;

 - iv. Offsite Lift Station flood mitigation.

 - a. proposals for additional work;
 - b. Park Use Agreements;
 - c. long-term park and recreational facility planning matters; and
 - d. Amended Order Establishing Park Rules.
