



Dear residents,

Nottingham Country Municipal Utility District (the “District”) is located within the West Harris County Regional Water Authority’s (the “Authority”) boundaries and is subject to the Authority’s rules and regulations, including with respect to drought response measures. Effective August 10, 2023, the Authority provided notice to the District that the Authority has implemented Stage 1 of its Drought Contingency Plan, which allows the Authority to request that users within its boundaries voluntarily reduce their respective water usage. In an effort to encourage the District’s residents to conserve water, to the extent desirable, the District’s Board of Directors elected to notify its residents of the Authority’s request for voluntary water conservation measures. However, the District is **NOT** currently implementing Stage 1 of the District’s Drought Contingency Plan.
